## Blue Santa Registration

To participate, sworn, retired, or reserve officers must fill in the <u>Blue Santa Registration Form</u>, then submit the form electronically and print the confirmation sheet. The officer will receive an email that includes their assigned Blue Santa # and instructions for toy pick-up. Volunteers will select and bag the toys and attach the Blue Santa #. Officers need to provide their printed or email confirmation form and Blue Santa # at the pick-up location. Gifts will be available for children **up to age 12** while supplies last.

Deadline to submit forms is extended to Thursday, December 15.
